Hello! My name is Ms. Rivera and I'll be your third grade teacher this upcoming school year. I'm so excited to meet all of you and get to know you all. I feel blessed to be part of the teaching staff here at Santa Rosa de Lima Catholic School. Can't wait to see what the new school year holds for all of us!

School's Mission Statement:

School Philosophy:

Classroom Rules:

- 1. Listen and follow directions.
- Be respectful to your classmates and teacher.

- 3. Raise your hand and wait for your turn to speak.
- 4. Keep your hands and feet to yourself.

Classroom Expectations:

- 1. Attend class every day and be prepared with all necessary school supplies.
- 2. iPads should be fully charged every night, and brought to school everyday.
- 3. Students are responsible for taking home their homework, completing it, and returning it to school.
- 4. Students are expected to pay attention, follow directions, participate, work in teams, and clean after themselves.
- 5. Cell phones are **NOT** to be used during school time. Students who have cell phones will be asked to turn them in at the beginning of class. If a student is caught with their cell phone it will be confiscated.
- 6. There are **NO** toys from home allowed in school.

Homework:

I will be assigning homework Monday through Thursday. Homework will be both electronic and in the form of paper handouts. Students will also be required to read for 15 minutes everyday. Daily reading is very beneficial as this will help your child with reading fluency and confidence. All homework must be turned in on time and fully completed.

The homework for Fridays is to attend Sunday Mass.

Classroom Discipline Policy:

There will be consequences for those students who break the rules.

- 1. They will get their first warning.
- 2. Second warning
- 3. Parents will receive a phone call/email.
- 4. Parents will be asked to come in for a conference.

In regards to classwork/homework assignments, students are encouraged to complete their daily classwork assignments, as well as their homework. <u>Students who do not complete their assignments or homework will be asked to stay in for recess.</u> Once they have completed their assignments, they will be excused to go out and play.

Parent Expectations:

- There will be a weekly Newsletter sent home every Monday. It is the parents responsibility to read these newsletters as important information will be posted.
- Grades will be posted every Friday evening. Please check SchoolSpeak on a regular basis, as this will help you see where your child might need additional support at home or if he/she is missing any assignments.

Curriculum:

<u>Math:</u> Students will be working with three-digit numbers: Place Value, Rounding Number to the Nearest 10 & 100's place, Addition, and Subtraction; Multiplication & Division; Fractions; Time; Perimeter & Area.

<u>Reading:</u> Students will be reading and comprehending complex literary and informational texts.

<u>Handwriting:</u> Cursive writing will be introduced this year. Students will continue using print on their assignments, and as we progress students will start using cursive.

<u>Religion:</u> Students will be learning about the origin of the Church's leadership, the Apostles Creed, the Seven Sacraments, Moral Conscience, and the Five Basic Forms of Prayers.

<u>Social Studies:</u> Students will be learning more about the physical and cultural landscapes of California, including the study of American Indians, the subsequent arrival of immigrants, and the impact they have had in forming the character of our contemporary society.

<u>Science</u>: Students will be learning about organisms' life cycles and adaptations, and space science.
