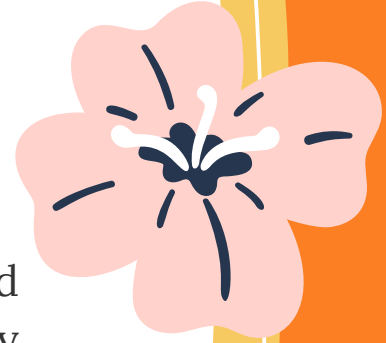


Philosophy

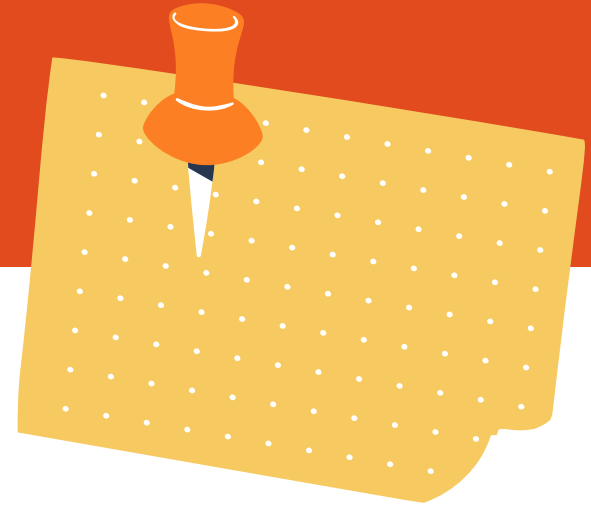


Living Document: Discipline Progression

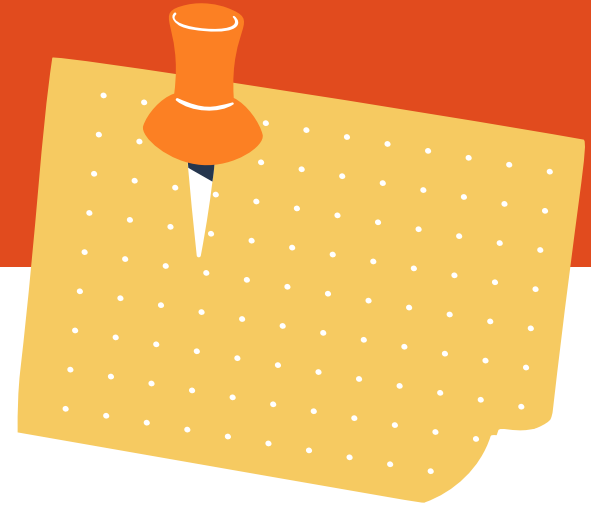

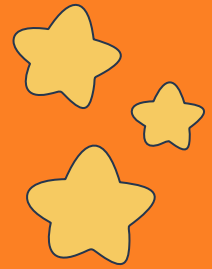

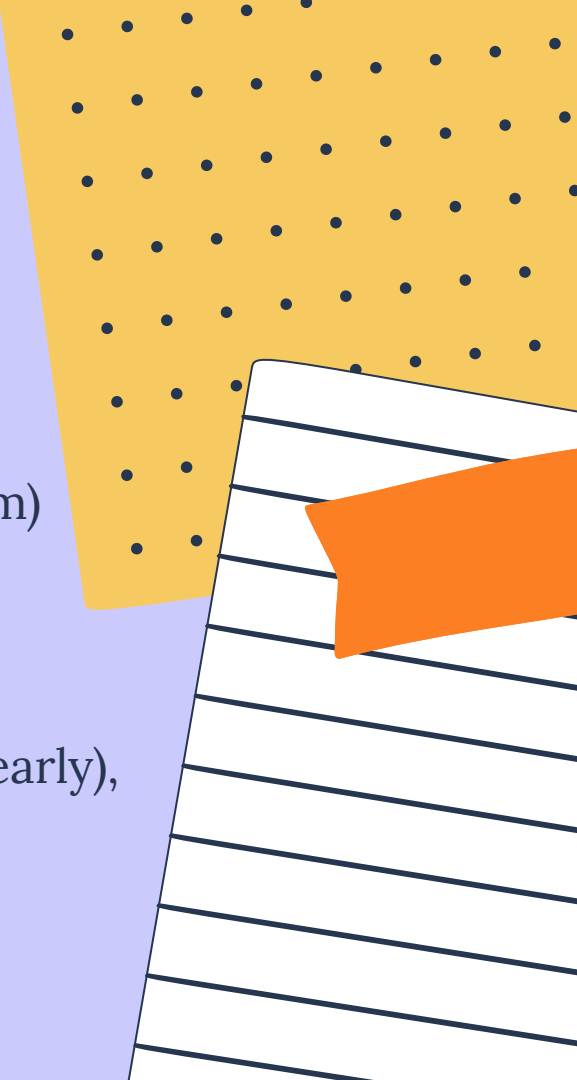
