#### SCHOOL PHILOSOPHY:

The development of a strong Christian largely depends on making responsible choices, starting now. A classroom discipline plan will be followed through to ensure that every student makes good decisions about his/her growth. Your child deserves the most positive educational environment to enhance their growth and spiritual well-being. The plan below outlines our rules, positive recognition for appropriate behavior and consequences for inappropriate behavior.

## CLASS RULES:

- 1. Treat EVERYONE, including the teacher, with respect
- 2. Follow directions
- 3. Keep your hands and feet to yourself
- 4. Raise your hand before speaking
- 5. Listen quietly teacher is speaking

Positive Recognition: To encourage students to follow these rules, appropriate behavior will be recognized with "class points" in the Class Dojo app. Students who receive only positive points throughout the week will receive a "treat or prize" on Friday.

# CONSEQUENCES:

Consequences will be applied accordingly for those students who break the rules.

- 4. Email to parents/phone call to parents

# HOMEWORK:

- 1. All students must write their homework assignment for that day on their agendas/ipads
- 2. Homework will be assigned MON-THURS nights. If a student is absent or has missing assignments, he/she must complete them over the weekend since all weekly assignments will be archived on Monday
- 3. Students will complete weekly math assignment on iReady
- 4. All assignments MUST be submitted on time and fully completed in order to receive full credit
- 5. All daily assignments will be posted on School Speak

- Academic integrity is highly regarded here. Cheating or plagiarism will not be tolerated and will result in an automatic "O" as his/her grade.
- 7. Please check SchoolSpeak on a consistent basis to keep on eye on your student's progress. Grades will be published every Friday.

MIDDLE SCHOOL CURRICULUM:

7th GR. MATH: Names & numerals for integers, decimals, ratios, percentages, exponents, fractions, scientific notation and root radical.

8th GR. MATH: Number sense and operations, algebra, geometry, and spatial sense, measurement, and data analysis and probability.

7th GR. LIFE SCIENCE: The study of living things; cells; heredity & genes; earth & life history; human body systems; structure and function in plants and animals

8th GR. PHYSICAL SCIENCE: Structure & properties of matter; gases, liquids, solids; chemical reactions; energy & matter

7th GR. RELIGION: Church structure and history; profession of faith;

8th GR. RELIGION: Feasts & Seasons; Sacraments; revelation; morality

TESTS:

It is your student's responsibility to take notes during class time and study for the test. All test dates will be posted on SchoolSpeak in order for you to check on your student's study habits.
