

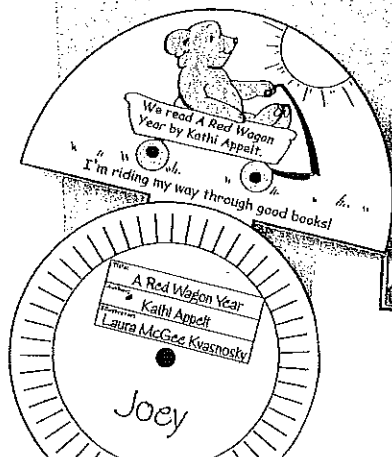
Please create the assigned project in response to the following books..

All three projects and the reading log will be due on the first day of school: August 14, 2024.

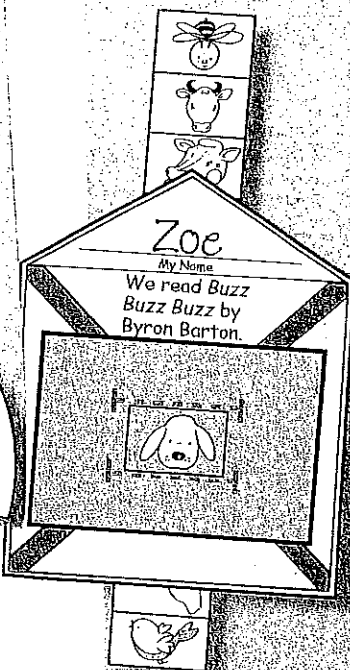
Wagon Spinner

1. Reproduce page 59 for students.
2. Provide a 9" (23 cm) paper plate and a paper fastener for each student.
3. Students color the wagon and draw a passenger in it. They fill in the book information.
4. Students cut out the forms.
5. Using the paper fastener, fasten the wagon to the paper plate. Glue the label to the plate.
6. Students write their names on the paper plate.



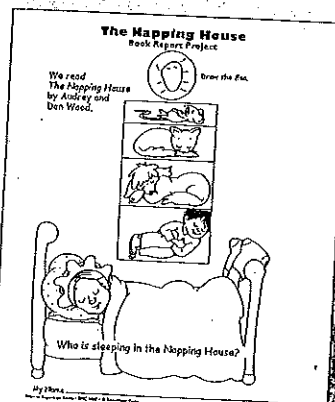
The Barn

1. Reproduce page 63 for students.
2. Students color and cut out the barn and the picture strip.
3. Cut the slits in the barn doorway.
4. Students slip the strip through the slits to show who is in the barn.



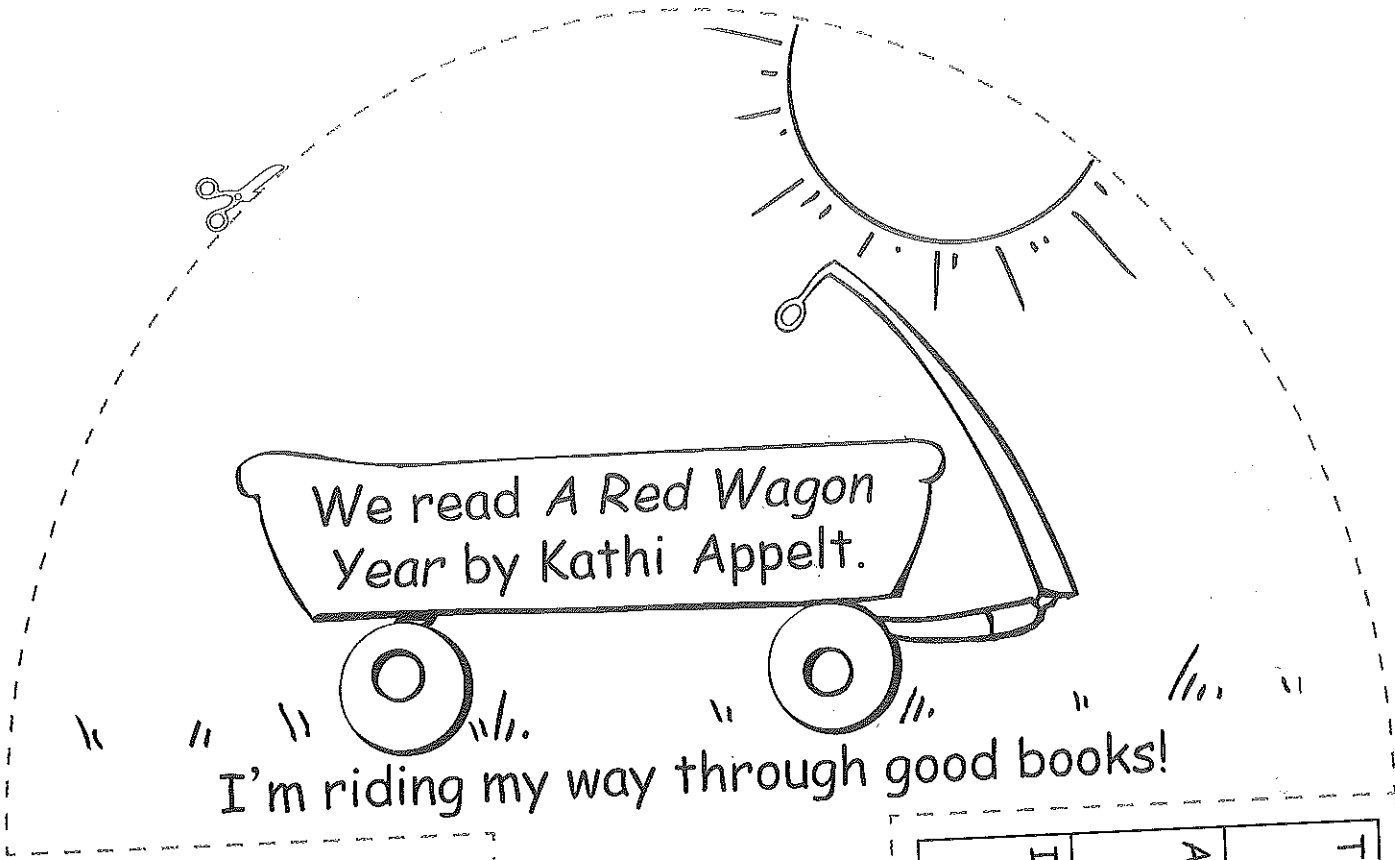
Cut-and-Paste Page

1. Reproduce the boxes at the bottom of this page and page 51 for students.
2. Students color the bed and the sleepers.
3. Students cut out the sleepers.
4. They glue them in the appropriate spaces.
